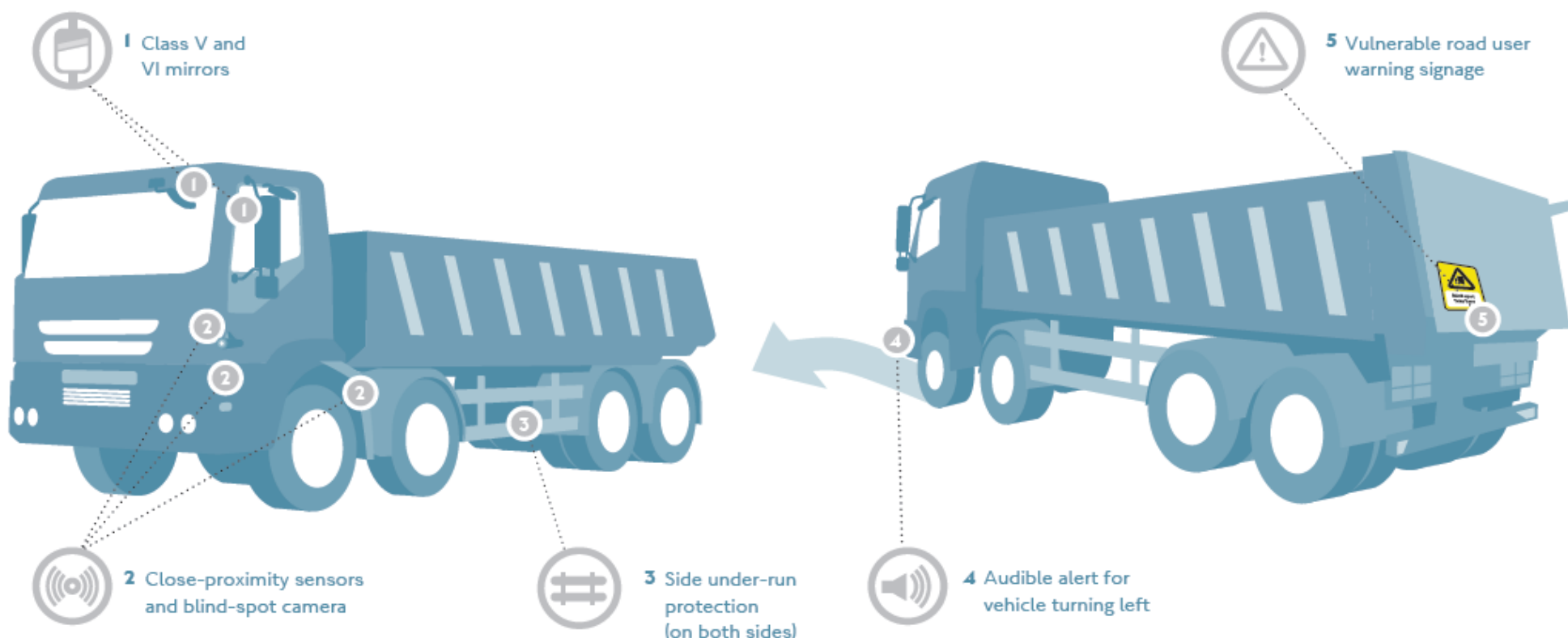


## Work Related Road Risk (WRRR)

From April 1<sup>st</sup> 2016, all suppliers of WestTrans member boroughs are required to comply with WRRR. To do so, three checks need to be made:



### 1. Vehicle Operator Check



Vehicle operator must be certified at a minimum of FORS bronze level or equivalent. FORS is the Fleet Recognition Scheme: [www.fors-online.org.uk](http://www.fors-online.org.uk)

### 2. Vehicle Check

Any vehicle over 3.5 tonnes gvw shall have the following vulnerable road user safety equipment fitted:

Blind spot minimisation:

1. Class V and VI mirrors
2. A method of minimising the vehicle blind spotseg. Camera system and/or Fresnel lens and sensor system
3. Side under-run protection (on both sides)
4. Audible alert for vehicle turning left
5. Vulnerable road user warning signage

### 3. Driver Check

- Driver must have valid driving licence for the vehicle they are driving
- Driver must be able to prove they have undertaken approved vulnerable road user training and e-learning
