



What is WRR?

Almost one third of traffic on London's roads is 'work-related'. Most work places and in particular construction sites, have very stringent Health and Safety (H&S) requirements, however once a vehicle and driver leaves its place of work, the employers H&S policies usually do not apply to the same extent. WRRR recognises this and encourages organisations to take responsibility for the safety and management of their vehicles which are still working for them, in the public realm.

From April 1st 2016, through their respective procurement processes, WestTrans member boroughs now require its suppliers (and their subcontractors) who utilise vehicles over 3.5 tonnes achieve Bronze accreditation under the Fleet Operator Recognition Scheme (FORS) by:

- undertaking additional driver training relating to vulnerable road users;
- checking your drivers hold appropriate licences and for any endorsements;
- installing additional vehicle safety equipment to minimise blind spots and notify others of intended manoeuvres;
- reporting, analysing and investigating collisions.
